The Customer

Espírito Santo Saúde (ESS) is responsible for defining and implementing the Espírito Santo Saúde Group’s development strategy in the areas of healthcare delivery and senior residences.

From the time of its founding in 2000, the Espírito Santo Saúde Group has built up an integrated network that includes hospitals, outpatient clinics and residential healthcare facilities, as well as various types of senior residences. Espírito Santo Saúde’s vision is to be a healthcare provider recognised as a benchmark of excellence and innovation in medical practice.

The group’s mission is clear: to diagnose and treat patients rapidly and effectively, with absolute respect for the patient’s

individuality, and to build an organization capable of attracting, developing and retaining exceptional people.

The Challenge

The hospitals of Espírito Santo Saúde Group had already built up a VDI infrastructure. In turn, the group sought a solution to turn away from the traditional desktop environment in favor of a virtualized desktop environment.

However, the financial challenge associated with acquiring the necessary client terminals created a need for a cost-effective endpoint solution. Together with Ozona Consulting, ESS selected Stratodesk's NoTouch Desktop as an appropriate solution to suit the goals of the Espírito Santo Saúde Group.

The idea was to find a way to utilize the existing hardware together with the group's VDI infrastructure. "The Espírito Santo Saúde Group has a large number of traditional desktops, and finding a way to reuse them was a great challenge. We were looking for a solution that would not only be agile in terms of implementation, but also one that could be centrally managed through a single console."

The Stratodesk Solution

The decision to use NoTouch Desktop from Stratodesk was easy. "We needed something that would work with the various brands of hardware that we currently support, would be easy to deploy, could be centrally managed, and one that could be integrated seamlessly with our existing VDI infrastructure. "With NoTouch Desktop, we are able to extend the life of our devices, and therefore benefit from an even greater return on investment," says Vieira.

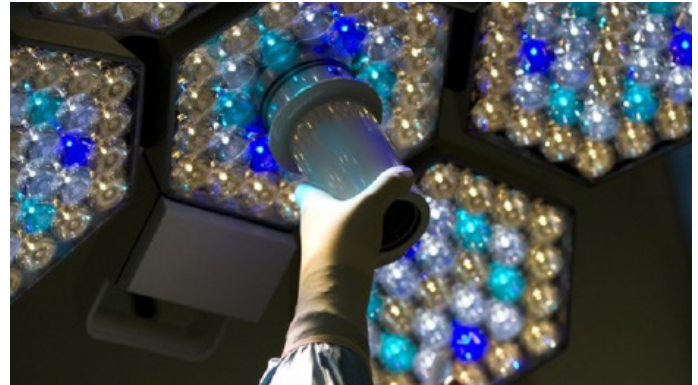
